paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land 20 feet wide, being 20 feet on East side side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across and now fenced

NW 2 SW 2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 27 Township 6 North 35 Range East W.M. beginning at Station 314/50 of the Sunnyside Umapine Highway Survey which station is approximately 1321 feet North and 6 feet East of the Sec Corner which is common to Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34 Township 6 North, Range 35 East W.M. Thence running in a Southerly direction approximately 400 feet to Station 316/50 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 921 feet North and 4.2 feet East of the Sec corner which is common to Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34 Township 6 N Range 35 East W.M.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
