

### In the Matter of Oregon Road

Known as the Ukiah - Albee Section of the Pendleton - John Day Highway

Know All Men by These Presents, That John P. Viebrock and Mary Viebrock his wife

of the County of Umatilla

in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar

paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land 80 feet wide being 40 feet on each side of the center line of said road as surveyed over and across the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21, T. 4 S.R. 31 E.W.M. and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at Station 265 / 16 of the said survey which station is approximately 1190 feet west of the quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 22, T. 4 S.R. 31 E.W.M. thence running in a northerly direction 3985 feet to Station 305 / 01 which station is approximately 1320 feet north and 808 feet west of the section corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, T. 4 S.R. 31 E.W.M. contains .732 acres more or less exclusive of existing roads.

As a further consideration Umatilla County is to fence both sides of the right of way with a three wire fence, posts one rod apart. A bridge is to be constructed as shown by the plans, Umatilla County to furnish grantor 200 feet of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
